“MANKIND’S GLOBAL CRISIS WITHOUT, AND WITHIN”

It is God's desire that all people come unto Him in full repentance, and receive His salvation, full and free. Those who respond and obey His command will be blessed bountifully: Spiritually, materially and physically, and even financially. The soul who rejects and rises up against the Lord, shall be "devoured by the sword," and there shall be no remedy for his tragic end. Do we dare provoke the Lord to jealousy? Do we dare contend our strength is greater than His? God forbid! He has the power to save, the power to devastate, the power to heal, the power to curse, the power to overcome, and the power to bless. I invite you to partake in today's message, entitled, "MANKIND'S GLOBAL CRISIS WITHOUT, AND WITHIN," and I pray that by the time it concludes, you will be encouraged to seek the Lord, Whose powers are limitless and can sustain you in every way.

The days are passing quickly for the benefit of those within the Body of Christ. Hence, Jesus Christ has promised to purposely shorten the days for the very elect's sake, so that His Church need not spend anymore time upon this earth than necessary. Therefore, as believers in Christ Jesus, let us make every minute, hour, day, and month in this New Year of 2022, count towards securing the salvation of our souls, through today's reading of God's Word within today's sermon topic.

James 5:7-8 denotes this wonderful promise, "Be patient therefore, brethren, unto the coming of the Lord. Behold, the husbandman waiteth for the precious fruit of the earth, and hath long patience for it, until he receive the early and latter rain. Be ye also patient; stablish your hearts: for the coming of the Lord draweth nigh."

Our Lord Jesus Christ is surely coming soon, and the signs in the heaven above and the earth beneath confirm His return to this earth as being very, very near...or sooner than many may think. The present state of this world is certainly in a global crisis, with much confusion, and chaos. Today's ongoing wars, threat of more international conflicts, and status of the global financial economy has never been more critical than in the times in which we are presently living.

The circumstances we now face have the potential to negatively affect everyone's personal safety, financial stability, and lifestyle. The present worldly forecast looks dim, without any promise for a happy future. Regardless of the severity of these circumstances, we believe wholeheartedly that Jesus Christ is in control and has determined His purpose for these times, to signal His return to the earth.

Therefore, it is with the utmost attention, that we must heed His instruction in Luke 21:19, "In your patience possess ye your souls."

There are still many today who have not accepted Jesus Christ as their personal Savior, Master, and Lord, and it is in the heart of God that all men should come to repentance. On a global scale, we see nations who are waiting for the right time to unleash their wrath on other nations for the sake of their personal beliefs. Then too, the global crisis is not restricted just to the circumstances without, in this present world, but it also applies to the global crisis and chaos, within the heart of mankind today.

There has been a great decline in moral and ethical values amongst not only those in positions of authority, but also in mankind at every station in life. We cannot remain ignorant of the fact that there is corruption in our own backyards, in the financial world, as well as in local, and national governments. In general, we are victims of instability, insecurity, envy, greed, and corruption, and Jesus Christ warns that these are just the beginning of sorrows, and the end is not yet.

What can we expect in the days that lie ahead and, especially in this New Year of 2022? According to God's Word, the overall atmosphere will worsen, with fear and insecurity being at the head of line. Sin is defined in God's Word as disobedience to the known will of God, and it is certain that sin will increase.

The curse of sin will be manifested in various forms, and diverse types of disguises to every man, woman, and child throughout the face of the earth. However, for those who have accepted Jesus Christ as their personal Savior, Master and Lord, they will be protected when they call on the Name of Jesus Christ, and plead for His Precious Blood to cover them, no matter how perilous the times might become.

The Lord Jesus Christ offers His remedial and corrective instruction for the New Year of 2022 in I Corinthians 5:6-8, "Your glorying is not good. Know ye not that a little leaven leaveneth the whole lump? Purge out therefore the old leaven, that ye may be a new lump, as ye are unleavened. For even Christ our passover is sacrificed for us: Therefore let us keep the feast, not with the old leaven, neither with leaven of malice and wickedness; but with the unleavened bread of sincerity and truth."

Spiritual patience, perseverance, obedience, and diligence are the attributes required to successfully take the Body of Christ, His Church, through the tough times that lie ahead of us all.

Paul admonished the Church at Thessalonica with Spiritual exhortations and Apostolic commands in II Thessalonians 2:7, "For the mystery of iniquity doth already work: only he who now letteth will let, until he be taken out of the way."

Jesus Christ will only accept those who willingly present themselves as a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable unto Him. God's people cannot expect to receive a reward in heaven, if they allow themselves to be simultaneously polluted by the things in this world.

God's Pastors must not only preach God's Word, but they must be able to lead and guide the Saints of God on to greater victory in Christ Jesus. Hence, God's Pastors must be filled with God's Holy Spirit to...1) Preach against sin; 2) Live, a life, above sin; and 3), Pray, encourage, motivate, reprove, rebuke, and inspire their congregations towards righteousness in Christ Jesus.

Mankind, when left to himself, will choose the natural course of action, which is to sin. As true born again Christians, we must not be caught unawares of these things, because Jesus Christ has forewarned, and comforted everyone to know that these things will come to pass.

However severe, in nature these events might be, they are just the tip of the iceberg, because the Lord Jesus Christ continues to warn His Believers that there is much more, yet to be revealed.

God's Word paints this vivid picture of the present day global crisis most appropriately in Matthew 24:6-8, "And ye shall hear of wars and rumours of wars: see that ye be not troubled: for all these things must come to pass, but the end is not yet. For nation shall rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom: and there shall be famines, and pestilences, and earthquakes, in divers places. All these are the beginning of sorrows."

Over the years many have tried to gainsay the words of Jesus Christ. Like those during the time of Jesus Christ who asked, "Where is the promise of His coming?" They will attempt to refute the soon-coming end of the world, saying that things will continue as they have been for the past millennium, and there is nothing to worry about.

Mankind's belief is that the international community will be able to solve the world's problems in time. Did you know that in every corner of the world there is some sort of military conflict, a famine, a devastating earthquake, great fires, or a deluge of water of great magnitude claiming many lives?

Today's present global crisis, will see nations of the world continue to send troops to help quell the oppression of war; send food and supplies to the famine stricken countries; or try to remove dictators from power in an effort to end tyranny and crimes against humanity.

However, the task at hand remains enormous, overwhelming, and without end. Why? Because the hand of the Lord Jesus Christ is causing all of these things to come to pass to wake men, women, and children up, everywhere, that He is coming soon.

Luke summarizes the return of the Lord Jesus Christ in glory in Luke 21:25-28, "And there shall be signs in the sun, and in the moon, and in the stars; and upon the earth distress of nations, with perplexity; the sea and the waves roaring; Men's hearts failing them for fear, and for looking after those things which are coming on the earth: for the powers of heaven shall be shaken. And then shall they see the Son of man coming in a cloud with power and great glory. And when these things begin to come to pass, then look up, and lift your heads; for your redemption draweth nigh."

The simplicity of salvation is complicated by the irreverence of mankind to God's Word. Mankind has his own method of how he thinks we should serve and worship, as delivered by King Solomon in Proverbs 14:12, "There is way which seemeth right unto man, but the end thereof are the ways of death."

Jesus Christ gave specific instructions to His disciples, and set the pattern for salvation of the soul of all mankind. Nicodemus, a Pharisee, approached Jesus Christ under the cloak of darkness, because of his love for righteousness that moved him to seek out Jesus Christ, and find out for himself what Jesus Christ requires of every man, woman, and child born into this world.

Although he was a scholar and a Pharisee, diligent and knowledgeable in the Laws of Moses, he knew that he lacked the truth found in the Gospel of the Kingdom of God that Jesus Christ preached. History indicates Nicodemus was one of the three richest men in Jerusalem at the time, and an active member of the Sanhedrin.

Upon conferring with Jesus Christ, Nicodemus believed, obeyed, and was baptized. Because of his conversion to the truth, and new-found faith in Jesus Christ, Nicodemus eventually was dismissed from his position and expelled from Jerusalem. That is when Nicodemus made his conscious decision to obey God rather than men. What brought about this significant change in the life of Nicodemus can definitely happen in our lives today, too.

We are no different today. We too, must obey the words of Jesus Christ, allowing humility into our lives, and let the Spirit of conviction have its perfect work. Being God-fearing believers, we must not hesitate to obey, and follow God's commandments for the salvation of our souls.

Reading in John 3:2 we see, "The same came to Jesus by night, and said unto him, Rabbi we know that thou art a teacher come from God: for no man can do these miracles that thou doest, except God be with him."

Jesus Christ is God, Himself, in the flesh, as described in I John 5:7, "For there are three that bear record in heaven, the Father, the Word, and the Holy Ghost: and these three are one."

The supremacy in Heaven above is designated to Jesus Christ, the Messiah, and Anointed. God, the Father, is a Spirit, and no man has seen God at any time. What mankind has beheld is the only approved image of the invisible God, which is Jesus Christ. Therefore, God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Ghost are one in the same, Jesus Christ.

God's Word in I John 5:8 unravels this mystery for our learning, "And there are three that bear witness in earth, the Spirit, and the water, and the blood: and these three agree in

one.” Here we find that Jesus Christ is in Supreme Control, of everything in heaven, and in earth.

In John 3:5 Jesus Christ establishes this commandment for all mankind to follow, “Jesus answered, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God.”

It is important to know that life, and immortality, have been brought to light for our understanding through the Gospel of the Kingdom of God that Jesus Christ preached. Therefore, being born of water, and being born of the Spirit are integral parts of God’s plan of salvation.

Peter instructs all mankind in Acts 2:38, “Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost.”

Water baptism is the act of a good conscience toward God, and Paul tells us that baptism resembles the death, burial, and resurrection of Jesus Christ. Likewise, those, who were baptized with the baptism of repentance by John, had to be re-baptized in the name of Jesus Christ to fulfill God’s Word to the very letter.

For them to be re-baptized confirms that they believed the truth of being baptized in the name of Jesus Christ as confirmed in Acts 4:12, “Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved.”

Hence, every Pastor and Minister today should be preaching this self-same Gospel that Jesus Christ, Himself, preached on the Shores of Galilee, rather than another gospel. One may ask the question, “Why are there so many churches, and different doctrines?”

God’s Word tells us there is one Lord, one faith, one baptism, and one God. The confusion comes when they interpret God’s Word, without letting God’s Holy Spirit help them. This points out, that they too, have not been baptized correctly in the name of Jesus Christ, and therefore, they cannot see the kingdom of God as confirmed in John 3:3, “Jesus answered and said unto him, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God.”

Jesus Christ instructed Thomas and His disciples in the upper chamber in John 14:6, “Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.”

Jesus Christ is God’s key to the Kingdom of God, and salvation of their souls for every man, woman, and child born into this world. The journey of God’s true church is coming to an end, and it is very evident per the present-day signs pointing to the global crisis of mankind both without, and within. God’s Body of Christ, His true Church, is spread across the face of the earth, and is eagerly awaiting His return.

We yearn to see Jesus Christ when He returns to meet us face to face in clouds of glory. We long to be relieved from the sin and oppression of this world, preferring to be with Him forever more. We do not enjoy the pleasures and treasures of this world, but instead look for the New Jerusalem, whose builder and maker is God. We long to be healed of our sick, afflicted, and tired bodies in this life, and we believe that when we see Jesus Christ, our bodies will be made whole.

Then too, in heaven there will be no more pain, no more death, no more sorrow, and no more such afflictions, and consequences. Hence, dear television viewers, we stand on the brink of entering the Kingdom of God, and we must then ask ourselves, "Are you prepared to meet Him?"

Today, we must believe the promises of Jesus Christ, and await His return in clouds of glory, to rapture His Saints. This meeting will take place in a twinkling of an eye, which is faster than a millisecond. It will occur suddenly, quickly, unexpectedly, and be likened to a thief in the night.

There is only one opportunity to be caught up in the Rapture, and that opportunity is ours today, so why not take advantage of this once in a life time opportunity to accept Jesus Christ as our personal Savior, Master, and Lord?

Jesus Christ provides comfort to all those who will believe in Him. And God's promises to His Believers are yea and amen, because Jesus Christ cannot lie, and He assures every believer of all ages, in this same manner.

Ezekiel 12:21-28 provides these thought-provoking verses, "And the word of the Lord came unto me, saying, Son of Man, what is that proverb that ye have in the land of Israel, saying, The days are prolonged, and every vision faileth? Tell them therefore, Thus saith the Lord God; I will make this proverb to cease, and they shall no more use it as a proverb in Israel; but say unto them, The days are at hand, and the effect of every vision.

For there shall be no more any vain vision nor flattering divination with the house of Israel. For I am the Lord: I will speak, and the word that I shall speak shall come to pass; it shall be nor more prolonged: for in your days, O rebellious house, will I say the word, and will perform it, saith the Lord God.

Again the word of the Lord came to me saying. Son of Man, behold they of the house of Israel say, The vision that he seeth is for many days to come, and he prophesieth of the times that are far off. Therefore say unto them, thus saith the Lord God; there shall none of my words be prolonged any more, but the word which I have spoken shall be done, saith the Lord God."

We must live today, knowing that Jesus Christ could come today, and tomorrow may be too late. Jesus Christ encourages us all in Matthew 24:12-13, "And because iniquity shall

abound, the love of many shall wax cold. But he that shall endure unto the end, the same shall be saved.”

As we approach the coming of the Lord Jesus Christ, the intensity and frequency of the tests, trials, and persecutions for righteousness sake will increase. No doubt our faith and commitment to Jesus Christ will be tested every day. Hence, we must persevere, and exercise our faith in Christ Jesus to see, and enter into the kingdom of God.

The very fundamentals of our faith are encapsulated in II Chronicles 7:14, “If my people, who are called by my name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land.”

Ezekiel instructed God’s People in Israel through the Spirit to admonish them because of the crisis within God’s church. Hence, we as true Saints of God must continue in God’s Word, and walk by His Holy Spirit, to be ready to hear Jesus Christ call up His waiting Bride saying, “Come up Hither, Come up Hither, Come up Hither.” 3, 2, 1....
