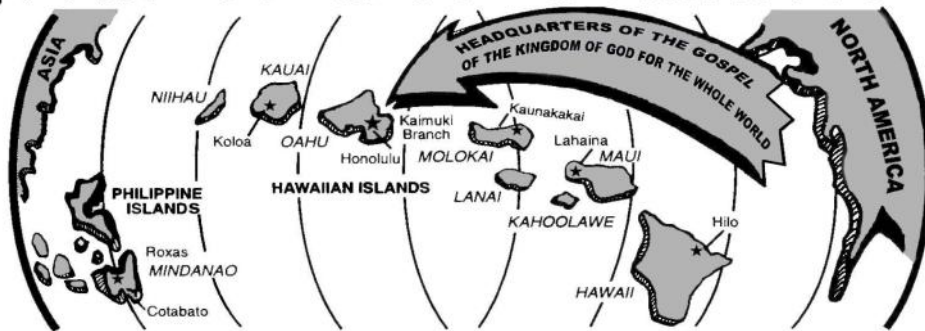

103 Years of Preaching the Gospel of Good News

Humble beginnings of kiawe trees sheltered a large white tent that accommodated the first services of The Apostolic Faith Church better known as “Jesus Coming Soon” for its landmark sign of the same, has blossomed into a Complex of Temple, Sunday School, Office and parsonage fronting a now bustling thoroughfare of Middle Street, the H-1 freeway access and nearby Bus and Sky Rail stations. Called to serve by the Lord, Pastors Charles and Sis. Ada Bea Lochbaum along with their son Otto sailed from California to Hawaii on the *SS Calawai* to preach The Gospel of the Kingdom of God. Establishing branch Churches in Kaimuki, Molokai, Maui, Hilo, Kauai and the Philippines along with a telecast and online ministry reaching around the world. In 1959, Chief Pastor William M. Han, Sr, aided by handmaiden Sis. Evangeline L. Han, was anointed to carry on the work of the Lord. Head Pastor William “Billy” M. Han, Jr., was raised up to continue the Lord’s work with devoted assistance by Hand Maiden Sis Roslyn Han.

Church Anniversaries bring much joy, hope and renewal of unity for our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. July 31st brought Saints of God from across the island chain for Friday’s tarrying service conducted by Kauai’s Pastor Leonard K. Y. Asano, Sr. The service be-

gan with musical selections of songs of praise for our Lord. Pastor Asano came forth with a spirit directed message. “...Who art thou...(John 1:22) providing how the Lord Jesus gives us an example of baptism by Jesus being baptized Himself by John the Baptist. Repentance of sin and baptism, the responsibility of tarrying for the Holy Ghost and standing with the Lord.

The sermon offered spiritual inspiration for the tarrying service that followed.

On Sunday morning August 2nd, Saints of God gathered to commemorate the 103rd Anniversary of the Headquarters Apostolic Faith Church, beginning with a musical prelude by the Church Band. Head Pastor

Billy Han, Jr., welcomed and led the congregation in “The Lord’s Prayer” followed with a joyous rendition of, “A Glorious Church”. The Church Orchestra directed by Trustee/Associate Edwin H. (baritone) accompanied by Sis. Kristie Han. Followed by a mix chorus of visiting Saints and their Pastors who sang an old time favorite, "Hold The Fort." Sis. Sierra Lynn Han with her beautiful full voice delivered a heartfelt solo of "Come Jesus Come." The congregation song of "Sweeter As The Years Go By" described the love of the Lord that He has for us and how it grows richer and deeper as we Stand with the Lord. Other wonderful selections by the Band, "Put Jesus First In Your Life" and the Choir closed the musical portion with the powerful number, "The Church Shall Stand Together."

Head Pastor Billy brought forth a spirit filled message of "103 Years of Good News." In his message he highlighted the history of the church in Hawai'i and the ultimate love and sacrifice the Lord has made for all of us. It is our responsibility to stay focused on the Lord and walk in His light always. We should be joyous in the Lord (*Philippians 3:2*). "Rejoice in the Lord always: and again I say, Rejoice" (*Philippians 4:4*).

Beware of things that take you away from the Lord least you be led astray (*Philippians 3:2,3*). Let the Lord lead and guide you. "...O LORD, thou art our father, we are the clay, and thou our potter" (Isaiah 64:8). Let the Lord have His way and be obedient to His word by being baptized in Jesus' name according to *Acts 2:38*, *John 3:5* and being filled with His Holy Spirit.

Ecclesiastes 12:13 highlights our responsibility, "...

Fear God and keep his commandments, for this is the whole duty of man." As Saints of God, we need to stand in unity and unified prayer. We need to keep on being stewards of the Gospel of Good News and "Looking for His blessed Hope" (*Titus 2:13*). The service closed with a song of hope and promise, "When We All Get To Heaven" and everyone left filled with much joy.

The celebration continued to the evening service with the Lord's Supper and Divine Healing. The evening started with a Prelude by the Church Band featuring old time favorites. Hawaii island Pastor Walter I. Tin Loy, was the preacher for the service. A musical highlight was the String ensemble directed by Sis. Edith Matsuki with Sis. Cherise Spotkaeff and Puuwai Asano (violins), Hannah Asano (cello), Senecca Kalilikane (cello) and Abigail Asano (bass). Bro. Marvin and Sis. Cherlyn Abing sang, "It's Not An Easy Road" which illustrated the challenging trials we will encounter and the joy of having the Lord's presence with us as we journey with Him. Pastor Tin Loy stressed the importance of taking the Lord's Supper and renewing our faith in God (*I Corinthians 5:28*), (*Matthew 28:26*), (*I Corinthians 11:26*), (*John 12:24*). We must not forget what the Lord has done for us. The 103rd Anniversary was a blessing for the Body of Christ. Jesus's return is sooner than we think and we must keep standing on the promises of God.

Gospel message

The Time Is Now

Are you ready? This is a question that only you can answer. Now you might be thinking, ready for what? The answer for that question is, for the coming of the Lord. As true believers in Christ Jesus, we can see the signs all around us. In *Matthew 24:4-7* Jesus warned the disciples of false Christs, false prophets that would deceive many. He warned of wars, and rumors of wars, nations against nations, kingdoms against kingdoms. Also famines, pestilences and earthquakes in diverse places. We see all of this and more happening right before our eyes. All of this is pointing to the fact that Jesus truly is Coming Soon!

In 1923, Pastor Charles and Sister Ada Bea Lochbaum were instructed by the Lord, to pack up all of their belongings and leave for Hawaii to preach the Gospel of Good News, to the people on the island of Oahu. They obeyed and followed the Lord's instructions. Due to their devotion and obedience, August 2, marks the 103rd Anniversary of the Mother Church at 1043 Middle Street. The leadership and teaching of the Gospel was later handed over to Chief Pastor William M. Han, Sr. and is currently under the guidance of Head Pastor William Han, Jr. who continues to preach nothing but the pure word of God.

What is the Gospel of Good News? It is the good news, that Jesus Saves, Jesus Heals, Jesus baptizes with the Holy Ghost and with Fire, and finally that Jesus is Coming Soon. This is the gospel that is preached at the Apostolic Faith Church, better known as the Jesus Coming Soon Church. This message must be preached to the entire world, then the end shall come (*Matthew 24:14*) "*And this gospel of the kingdom shall be preached in all the world for a witness unto all nations; and then shall the end come.*" The main purpose of the gospel, is to see souls saved by being baptized in the name of Jesus by immersion (meaning to be dipped or plunged completely under the water) in the name of Jesus. according to (*John 3:5*) "*Jesus answered, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God.*" On the day of Pentecost, Peter invoked the baptism in the name of Jesus in (*Acts 2:38*) "*Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost.*" Peter made it perfectly clear that baptism should be ad-

ministered in the name of Jesus. In *Acts 4:12* Peter tells the people "*Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved.*" Praise the Lord, Jesus is the only saving name.

We live in exciting times, the *Word of God* tells us that Jesus will come as a thief in the night (*Matthew 24:43*) we need to be vigilant, if you hear something that doesn't line up with what we have learned. Turn to the *Word of God* and the Lord will give you the answer. Yes, Now Is The Time, for a soul to believe and be saved, Now Is The Time, for the believer to stand upon the promises of God, for Jesus is Coming Soon! He will come in clouds of glory to catch up His bride (*I Thessalonians 4:16-17*) then we shall be with the Lord forever!

Editorial

The Old Time Religion

The Old Time Religion to many mean different things and that's why the world is led so easily away from the Lord. The word religion is defined as "a personal set or institutionalized system of attitudes, beliefs and practices." As we find in the *Word of God*, this definition fails, because it shows man's wisdom and lets man decide what he wants to do. The greatest part of this Old Time Religion is The Gospel of the Kingdom of God. The good news that, Jesus saves, Jesus heals, Jesus baptizes with the Holy Ghost, and with fire, and Jesus is Coming Soon.

Jesus instructed the Apostles, "...Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature. He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned (Mark 16:15,16)." Salvation is for everyone, every man, woman, and child, no matter what color, creed, or nationality. If you believe, you must be baptized! The signs that follow true believers are found in Mark 16:17,18. These scriptures prove to all where the truth is and that is at The Apostolic Faith Church, located at 1043 Middle Street, Honolulu, Hawaii and at all its branch churches. Many devils have been cast out, many have been healed of sickness and disease in the name of Jesus. The "new tongue" is spoken as the Spirit gives utterance (Acts 2:4, I Corinthians 14:22).

On the day of Pentecost the Apostle Peter spoke to the multitudes saying, "... Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost (Acts 2:38)." You see how The Old Time Religion does not change? Here Peter tells all to first repent. Repentance is Godly sorrow for sin, humbling ourselves before The Lord. Then one needs to be baptized in water, in the name of Jesus Christ. Why? Because only the name of Jesus can save, Acts 4:12 states, "Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved." In John 3:5, "Jesus answered, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God." This message that Jesus shared with Nicodemus, he shares with you and I. We must be born again to enter into the Kingdom of God.

To hold on to The Old Time Religion, we must stand fast to what Jesus has given us. Paul wrote to the Philippians, "Only let your conversation be as it becometh the gospel of Christ: that whether I come and see you, or else be absent, I may hear of your affairs, that ye stand fast in one spirit, with one mind striving together for the faith of the gospel (Philippians 1:27)." To stand fast we must

always keep the gospel (the *Word of God*) in our hearts and continue to talk about Jesus, letting the Holy Spirit work in our hearts so that the Lord can always find the Body of Christ in unity. In *Philippians 1:28* we are further instructed, "And in nothing terrified by your adversaries: which is to them an evident token of perdition, but to you of salvation, and that of God." When we stand fast in The Old Time Religion we should never be afraid of anyone or anything because nothing or no one can take away our salvation as long as we stand fast. As we are taught, "...greater is he that is in you, than he that is in the world (I John 4:4)."

The Lord and His doctrines are unchanging. The same Word He preached on the shores of Galilee to all, is The Old Time Religion that we preach today. The Lord and His Apostles preached it then, we preach it now, and will continue to preach The Old Time Religion until Jesus comes again in clouds of glory to take His people home. "Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and to day, and for ever (Hebrew 13:8)." Like the song says, "it was good enough for Paul and Silas, then it's good enough for me."
